

**Answer:** First N Foremost, Great question! Material prices vary from state to state and across the country. The average price you should pay for a completely wood deck is between \$17-\$25 per sq. Foot. The average price you should pay for a wood deck with composite decking and rails anywhere between \$32-\$45 per sq. Foot. There are many variables i.e. railings, screws vs. Nails, grade of lumber, or grade of composite decking, for a 12'×12'wood deck you should be paying between \$2448-\$3600. For a composite covered deck that same 12'×12' deck could cost anywhere from \$3600-\$6480. Composite decking does have lower maintenance cost over the long haul, but the initial cost is 50%to 100% more than your average wood deck...
